What is this Trip all about?

Restore Trinity

The Campaign to Restore Trinity Claiborne is a collaborative effort of Camp Restore / RAI Ministries, former Trinity members, current Lower 9th Ward residents and area Lutheran clergy. The goal of this project is to simultaneously assess the ministry needs of the area, while rebuilding a facility that meets those needs ... so that the light of Jesus Christ can continue to shine in the Lower 9th Ward! The October mission trip will be made up of two teams—**Construction & Outreach Team**.

Construction Team

After many months of planning, the physical restoration of Trinity Claiborne is about to begin.

Work for the week will include:

- Demolition
- Structural
- Framing
- Roofing

This first team will have the responsibility of laying the groundwork for all other teams that follow.

Outreach Team

In a joint partnership with staff of RAI Ministries, former Trinity members and the Chicago team, plans are underway to reach the residents of the Lower 9th Ward.

During our week we will:

- Host a cook out at Trinity, inviting the residents of the Lower 9th to an afternoon, of Bingo, kids' games, a health fair, music, fellowship and Jambalaya!
- Lead small groups and conduct home visits to access needs of the community
- Prayer Walks
- Serve at area schools and community organizations

Who Is Needed?

Construction Team

A servant's heart is the only prerequisite for the construction team. While prior construction or remodeling experience is a plus, all are invited, as many hands make for light work.

Outreach Team

Love to connect with people? Has God blessed with you the gift of mercy, teaching, leading, or serving? We have a place for you!

Is the trip open to anyone?

The trip is open to everyone age 16 + older. (Those age 16-17 must complete a parental consent form). Volunteers do not need to be a member of one of the participating congregations. We welcome everyone to be a part of our team!

Note: All mission team members must be covered on a health insurance plan.

How do we travel to New Orleans?

There will be a coordinated car pool that departs the NW suburbs on the morning of Saturday, October 16 arriving at Camp Restore on Sunday, October 17. The car pool will depart from Camp Restore on Saturday, October 23 Please consider being a driver for this trip (fuel expenses will be reimbursed). We'll assist in coordinating passengers/drivers.

How much does it cost?
